Take I-87 / NYS Thruway North to Exit 19 - Kingston, Merge on Rt. 28 West, take ramp to onto Rt. 209 North and follow for approximately 3 miles, Take the Enterprise Dr. exit, keep left at fork, after traffic light follow signs to Neighborhood Rd. Turn left at Enterprise Dr. Turn left at Neighborhood Rd./Town Hall Drive. Town of Ulster Town Hall will be on your left.

From Dutchess County/Kingston-Rhinecliff Bridge:

Go Northwest on Rt. 199, continue on Rt. 209 South, Take the Enterprise Dr. exit, keep left at fork, after traffic light follow signs to Neighborhood Rd. Turn left at Enterprise Dr. Turn left at Neighborhood Rd./Town Hall Drive. Town of Ulster Town Hall will be on your left.

From NYS Thruway Exit 19 - Kingston:

Merge on Rt. 28 West, take ramp to onto Rt. 209 North and follow for approximately 3 miles, Take the Enterprise Dr. exit, keep left at fork, after traffic light follow signs to Neighborhood Rd. Turn left at Enterprise Dr. Turn left at Neighborhood Rd./Town Hall Drive. Town of Ulster Town Hall will be on your left.

From Sullivan County:

Take Rt. 209 South to Kingston, Take the Enterprise Dr. exit, keep left at fork, after traffic light follow signs to Neighborhood Rd. Turn left at Enterprise Dr. Turn left at Neighborhood Rd./Town Hall Drive. Town of Ulster Town Hall will be on your left.
